
There is a lighting board with stage lights that you can take advantage of.



Functionality

- The exterior of the location could be used as a restaurant, castle, small reception. It is relatively easy to rent the Hangar Theatre as long as it is done far enough in advance (since there are plays, lectures and other performances that normally rent it out). The interior lobby could be used as part of a small reception thanks to the chairs and tables set up. It could also be used as a lobby for a theatre. Aside from that there wasn't too much that the lobby would be good for filming wise.
- The theatre interior could be used for a film that had an off Broadway/ small play, or a lecture of some kind. It is temporarily being used to hold religious services. Sound carried a lot inside the theatre and should be mixed/monitored during filming. The building had a green room and dressing rooms where actors and extras could be held.
- The building next door (still part of the theatre though) is a construction workshop and would be great to have to hold scenery and wardrobe. Issues with the theatre would possibly be the A/C and ventilation systems (there was an audible, but not loud humming) and that there is a park next to the theatre that might hold events (although the building manager said he has never seen one)
